Listen to your Heart

"Listen to your heart, not only your head" is the advice of Luke Johnson, Chairman of StartUp Britain to all entrepreneurs. I think that the advice is not only meant for those in the corporate world. It applies to us, leaders in ministry, who have to use motivation, persuasion and sternness alongside with education and rational thinking.

Often times I see myself needing the ability to persuade, inspire and entreat a rare gift that cannot be acquired solely through classroom study, books or computers. The core of any achievement will

depend on personal relationships and I try to maintain them. It is these interactions that are dependent more upon charisma than calculation. "Managers who lack charm", says Luke Johnson "will not gain true loyalty for their team...computers and robots will not choose the

right partner for a new venture or convince bankers to fund it. It requires passion to persuade and generate excitement."

Our very own Pope Francis is a leader with passion, charisma and charm down to earth. His expressions, "*Good morning! I greet you. Thank you so much for all this. Pray also for me; but always! Pray in favor, not against! May the Lord bless you.*" Father Lombardi calls this a genre that might be termed "conversational," comprising not only the Pope's interviews with journalists but also his off-the-cuff homilies at daily morning Masses, of which the Vatican publishes only summaries with verbatim excerpts.

Pope Francis' style has proved to be both simple and profound. By riding in a modest car and living in an unadorned apartment, he sends a clear message: material possessions are fleeting. Choose to attach yourself to God, not the things of this world. By reaching out to workers at the Vatican and calling upon ordinary Catholics in moments of crisis, he lives out the Lord's command to love our neighbor.

Pope Francis has been wonderfully adept at calling us to these Christian principles. He has won over many disaffected Catholics, and his words of compassion for the suffering, for gays and lesbians, and for unbelievers have already reshaped the image of the church in the world. +*Lumen, CSC*

The long wait for the revised edition of 'Logesong', the Diocesan Book of Prayers and Hymns of the Diocese of Agartala, is hopefully over. Here are some thoughts on a book that has now become part and parcel of the Catholic Church in Tripura. It's an excerpt from the 'Preface' found in the new edition. 'For the last 30 years *'Logesong'* has indeed proved to be an invaluable 'Companion' to the ever increasing number of Catholic faithful in Tripura, assisting them in their endeavour to grow in faith and evolve as a worshipping Community.

The fifth revised edition of *Logesong*, like its earlier editions, signals growth, not only in the number of the faithful, but of faith itself as evinced by the perennial longing in our hearts to commune with the divine ever more perfectly, ever more experientially. It is hoped the new edition of the book, that contains some additions and changes, will be of great help to the faithful in their endeavour to pray, sing and to experience the divine.


After the revised text of the Holy Mass, it is perhaps the psalm-based Sunday Morning Prayer (Lauds) that will prove to be the singular contribution of the fifth edition. It enables the Kokborok speaking faithful to join countless tongues and peoples who have throughout history communed with God using the sentiments of these timeless compositions. One hopes it will engender a prayer habit that is more vigorous and scripture-based.

There are instances, in this volume, where the Church's concern for cultural rootedness of the faith comes vividly alive. These sporadic attempts however, serve at least to remind one of the great deal of work that yet needs to be done in this direction. One wishes for a liturgy that while being fully consonant with the teachings and traditions of the Church, has the unmistakable flavor of a place and its people.

The new edition retains the 'multi-lingual' nature of the compendium that began in the previous edition. With the exception of English and Bengali, all languages included in the book are passing through turbulent times. A volume of this sort, however defined and limited in scope, is bound to impact the language scenario of the community. Current trends in the given languages and dialects, therefore, have been considered while compiling *Logesong*.

Repatriation

On 30th September 2013, fifty six families from Naisingpara, twenty eight families from Ashapara and two families from Hezacherra Relief Camp repatriated to Mizoram. The families repatriated on their own decision as a Self-repatriation. A list of 120 families were selected by Mizoram Government and sent to the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) of Kanchanpur for repatriation without the knowledge of MBDPF. Out of 120 selected families, 86 families have repatriated to Mizoram. The MBDFP leaders and members extended their full cooperation and help to the Government authority in the repatriation process.

Strategy development workshop for engaging the Bru leaders

On 17th and 18th September 2013 a Workshop on Strategy Development for engaging the Bru leaders to develop the process was conducted at Naisingpara, JUST field office. 33 participants took part in the programme from different relief camps. Arul Selvan programme Coordinator of Peace project facilitated the Program. Mr. Lalrinpuia Molsoi was the resource person for the program. The major aspects discussed in the program were, Education and its importance, Health and Hygiene, Need for Repatriation and Expectation from the Govt. of Tripura & Mizoram.
